- Determine and implement a Project Health & Safety training program based on the site specific needs.
- Provide Workers Compensation and Rehabilitation support and advice and manage the process.
- Regularly attend contractors pre start meetings and tool-box meetings and assist with presentation of material and training.
- Approximately 80% field work is expected.
